Administrative Order No. 2023 - <u>159</u>

Pursuant to Rule 35(b)(3), Arizona Rules of the Supreme Court, the Court must establish the minimum acceptable score for applicants taking the uniform bar examination in Arizona, or for applicants seeking to transfer a uniform bar examination score from another jurisdiction. Rule 35(b)(7) also requires the Court to establish the minimum acceptable score for the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination.

Therefore, pursuant to Article 6, Section 3, of the Arizona Constitution, and Supreme Court Rule 35,

IT IS ORDERED that applicants will be deemed to have satisfied the requirements of the Arizona Uniform Bar Examination ("UBE") by achieving a minimum score of 270 effective beginning with the July 2023 test administration and for all subsequent administrations until further Order of this Court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicants for Uniform Bar Examination score transfer must have achieved a minimum score of 273 prior to the July 2023 test administration or must have achieved a minimum score of 270 effective beginning with the July 2023 test administration and for all subsequent administrations until further Order of this Court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that applicants for admission on motion in connection with the three-year bar examination lookback provision in Ariz. R. Sup. Ct. 34(f)(4) must have achieved a minimum score of 273 prior to the July 2023 test administration or must have achieved a minimum score of 270 effective beginning with the July 2023 test administration and for all subsequent administrations until further Order of this Court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED confirming that Arizona applicants must achieve a minimum score of 85 on the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination ("MPRE") until further Order of this Court.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the minimum score requirements be posted by the Court's Certification and Licensing Division on the Attorney Admissions Website.
