Permitted Items:

- Wallet
- Money, credit card
- Government issue ID for entry
- Keys
- Non-digital (analog) wristwatch
- Sunglasses, eyeglasses, contact solution, eyedrops
- Prescription Medication(s) with prescription label
- Non- Prescription Medication(s) - removed from packaging
- Feminine hygiene products
- Transparent water bottle(s) - with no label or writing
- Laptop, power cord, wired mouse, wired keyboard - MEE and MPT test day if laptop certified

Arizona Supreme Court Rule 34(e)(2) states the application for admission and all of the documents required to be submitted by the Arizona uniform bar examination applicant must be timely submitted, with required fees, in accordance with the schedule and filing fees established by the Court. In the event an application, documents or fees are submitted after the initial filing deadline, late fees as established by the Court shall be assessed. No application, documents or fees will be accepted after the close of the applicable filing deadline, shown below.
